Title: Accept grants from Persimmon and the National Lottery fund

# **Purpose of Report:**

For Members to note the receipt of two grants from Persimmon Homes and National Lottery.

# **Recommendation:**

- A. Members to NOTE the receipt of a £1,000 grant from Persimmon Homes to purchase replacement dog bins for Herne Hill.
- B. Members to NOTE the receipt of a £3,285 grant from The National Lottery Awards For All to purchase a Lowther Bench and a wheelchair accessible picnic bench for both West Crescent and Winterhay playparks.

# Report:

#### **Persimmon Grant**

- 1. The dog bins up on Herne Hill are no longer fit for purpose and need replacing.
- 2. Officers, in consultation with the Open Spaces Manager, identified a suitable type of replacement bin.
- 3. A grant application was completed and submitted on 17 January 2024 for £1,000 towards the cost of replacing 5 dog bins, which at the time was £1,047.40
- 4. An email was received dated 9 February 2024 awarding the Town Council a grant of £1,000.00.
- 5. The additional funds £47.40 required to purchase the five new dog bins are available under dog bin purchases.
- 6. Members to **NOTE** the receipt of a £1,000 grant from Persimmon Homes to purchase replacement dog bins for Herne Hill.

# **National Lottery Awards For All Grant**

- 7. As part of the CiLCA qualification, a learning outcome is to apply for grant funding towards a project within one of the council's functions.
- 8. The results of the Community Consultation held in November/December 2022, as part of the Community Plan, strongly indicated that residents would like to see picnic benches and benches placed at both Winterhay and West Crescent Play Parks.
- 9. Officers, in consultation with the Open Spaces Manager, identified two suitable benches, one of each type to be placed at West Crescent and Winterhay Play Parks.

- 10. A grant application was completed and submitted on 16th January 2024 for £3,285 towards the cost of purchasing and installing two benches and two wheelchair accessible picnic benches.
- 11. An email was received dated 23 February 2024 awarding the Town Council a grant of £3,285. The grant covers the purchase and installation costs of all four benches. There will be no cost to the Council.
- 12. Members to **NOTE** the receipt of a £3,285 grant from The National Lottery Awards For All.
