Litter picking project idea

Litter picking in the Recreation Ground is done by 1 of the groundsmen every morning but this leaves the rest of the day and evening where there is no litter being collected. Having a litter picking stand where the public can have access to a litter picker and a bin bag will allow those who want to help the park look clean be able to, without having to buy their own equipment. It would not cost very much to implement this project as all we would need are 2 or 3 litter pickers which I have found on Tudor for £6.50p. The only other items we would need are a piece of plywood to hold the litter pickers in and a supply of bin bags. An area by the board for people to leave the bin bags they have filled. A piece of ply would be £30.00 and the fixings would be screws or bits of dowel so we can do that with no issue. We could have 1 in the rec and possibly 1 at the Herne path so people can keep Herne HIII tidy if they choose too

The implementation of this would allow for a cleaner, tidier recreation ground and Herne Hill also it means on weekends if the public wish too they can keep the rec looking good even when we are not here over the weekends.
