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Morning Mark,

As discussed a while ago we have finally had a drawing done to help explain our proposed path drainage plan as below.

I met with Jake and we talked through a way for ISCL to expose the current drainage that runs throughout our pitch and into the ditch by the canal. Our need to uncover the drainage is so we can have a contractor come in and clean out the drains to ensure that maximum drainage is achieved for our pitch to enable games to continue during bad spells of weather. I proposed to Jake that whilst we are exposing the drains we could assist the TC by helping aid drainage on the path next to the canal that is notorious for turning into a bog after spells of rain. We would achieve this as per the drawing attached. Jake was happy with our proposed plans as it will benefit all.

There will be no cost at all to the TC, All costs will be covered by ISCL. Jake has said he would clear out the ditch a little more to assist drainage.

Obviously things to consider would be that we would have to close that path off of whilst works are carried out which should take no longer than a week.

Could we please ask that this goes to the appropriate council meeting for consideration.
