Title: Christmas Lights Storage

Purpose of Report

For members to note the increase rent charges

Recommendation:

Members to note the increase in rent for the Christmas Lights

Report:

- 1. The Town Council has over the years paid for the storage of the Christmas Lights in Ilminster. This facility is not just a storage facility but is also the venue where the lights are tested and maintained before being put up.
- 2. The lights are purchased and owned by the Town Council with the Christmas Lights Committee giving their considered opinion on what lights are required each year.
- 3. The last time that there was a rent increase was in 2017 when it increased from £150 to £225.
- 4. The lights committee have been notified that there has been an increase from 1 January 2024 to £300 per annum. Whilst this is a large increase in rent it represents an average increase of 4.7% per annum over the 7 years. The budget will be adjusted to cover the increase from General Reserves and the 2024-25 budget will take into account the increase.
- 5. Currently there are no alternative locations that fulfil the requirements for storage, maintenance and testing of the lights throughout the year. There is a need to keep the lights in as central location as possible.
- 6. Members to note the increase in rent for the Christmas lights.
