**Title: Financial Monitoring Report** 

## **Purpose of Report**

To report the income and expenditure figures from 1st April 2023 to 31st August 2023.

## Recommendation:

Members to note the finance report.

## Report:

- The income and expenditure for Open Spaces and the cemetery are found on Appendix 7A. Details of income and expenditure in July and August are explained below.
- 2. A donation of £20.00 was made for a memorial plaque to be fixed to a bench. The licence fees for the cricket pitches, pavilion, insurance and emptying of the septic tank was received £1,231.38.
- 3. The fire extinguishers at the Warden's Building were checked and serviced costing £152.45. The water/sewerage invoice for the Warden's Building £228.49 which covers a six-month period was paid. The two months of direct debit for electricity was £76.20.
- 4. The fuel invoices totalled £898.48 which covers two months of the busiest time of year for grass cutting. The summer bedding plants for the troughs, hanging baskets and planters cost £1,078.15.
- 5. Expenditure on materials and tools such as paint, stain, brushes, drill bits, sanding plates, hoses and locks came to £532.58. The first service of the Ferris was £234.88, and the Kioti service was £294.85.
- 6. The two sets of posts and nets for the tennis courts cost £712.84.
- 7. The annual emptying of three septic tanks cost of £450.00. The utility invoices for the public conveniences were £179.30 for water and £60.96 for electricity. The two months cleaning invoices totalled £563.34. Following the vandalism in July, the cost of replacing the toilet roll dispensers was £100.00.
- 8. Total expenditure from 1st April to 31st August was £30,558.17, and income £3,484.16.
