Title: Permission for a plaque under a tree in the cemetery

Purpose of Report

To allow for committee members to consider granting permission for a plaque

Recommendation:

Members to grant permission to place a plaque under a tree in Section D of the cemetery.

Background:

1. A member of the public emailed the Town Council office to research the grave of Mary Ann Rowe. It was discovered to be in Section D of the cemetery, however, there was no headstone and it is very difficult to identify the exact location.

Report:

- 1. The member of the public and has now asked if she can place a memorial somewhere in the area of Section D to mark the unmarked grave of Mary.
- 2. Officers looked for a suitable place for the suggested memorial and found that these two trees are in the middle of the mass graves where Mary Ann Rowe was buried in section D.
- 3. If it was agreed by members, it is suggested that a plaque could be placed under either of these trees.
- 4. As with other memorials, the office staff would request to see any wording before permission is granted to place a plaque in the cemetery.
