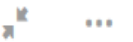

In relation to the above statistics the Miscellaneous crimes against society are crimes that don't have a specific title and no offences related to them, they are simply something that has been recorded but of no real value.

The Non recordable is a neighbourly issue which again is recorded but for information only.

Covid Breaches as follows,

We had 13 breaches so far which is very low for a Town this size,

- 3 of which were party related, 2 of the parties resulted in Penalty Notices and one finished before arrival,
- 1 for someone not self isolating,
- 1 for an incorrect use of a support bubble which resulted in 2 Covid Warnings,
- 1 for someone visiting indoors which could not be proved,
- 2 calls for a Gym opening against Government Restrictions, this could not be proved,
- 5 turned out to be malicious calls with no breaches.
