
Good evening to you all in Ilminster. The Beat Team, of Ilminster, has as usual been kept busy with the normal happenings of a Town this size.

Following our last report the Old Horlicks Site has now been secured by a security company and is being monitored.

We are also in the process of arranging training to enable us to set up community speed watch where we are having consistent speeding issues and can gather enough volunteers.

Most of our calls have come in from the Orchard Vale area. We have had several unsettling incidents in Orchard Vale and continue to work with the residents to reassure them and keep an eye on the situation. Yarlington are involved and we are working together for a solution to the problems that are being caused.

We continue to keep an eye on ASB in the Recreation Ground. High visibility patrols are being carried out by the beat team when on shift and continuous engagement with the youths regarding their behaviour.

We have received several reports of ASB in Tesco carpark involving several different cars. We have been working hard to catch these drivers in the act but as yet they have not shown up when we are on shift. We have however spread the word that we are monitoring the situation and we be taking action if caught which seems to have got around.

We have seen a return to nearly normal life as the lockdown measures continue to be relaxed and have had no issues regarding Covid – 19 in the last month. That said we continue to monitor the situation and make sure the residents of Ilminster are sticking to the few remaining measures.

To summarise we have had a busy month and are working hard to ease the situation on going in Orchard Vale.
