3. Full details of project for which a grant is sought: with emphasis on how it will benefit the citizens of Ilminster

We would like to run some senior school awareness sessions for young people living, schooling or socializing in Ilminster. On average, it will take 6-7 years for someone to recover from Anorexia Nervosa. However, evidence shows that the earlier someone receives help for an eating disorder, the more likely they are to recover. The most likely time for an eating disorder to begin is when a person is in their teenage years and, once patterns are established, it can be very difficult to reverse the behaviours associated with eating disorders. Offering awareness training and or support as soon as problems emerge means that the young person can go on to lead a full and fulfilled life rather than one dominated by issues around food and eating.

Eating disorders are on the increase in young people with more boys suffering than ever before and the age of presentation with disordered eating is dropping. Somerset and Wessex have their own eating disorder charity to address this but funds are needed for the work to continue.
