I would like to also state for the record that I go out of my way to support the Town I Pay for the fag for the summer experience and towards the Christmas lights I also sponsor local people. I also know the person in question only works two days a week and you don't have to be Einstein to work out why it's properly to stay under 11,000 a year so he doesn't have to pay any tax so in my mind it's a Loop hole in the system for people to exploit to earn a quick buck and if the council wishes to support people like that rather than local traders that are there every day paying a lot to be there.
