Report:

- A letter has been received from the Somerset Local Authorities Civil
 Contingencies Partnership (SLACCP) requesting that the council provide
 three contacts that can be contacted at a time of emergency. Appendix 18A.

- 3. It is clear that this is something that links with the resilience work that the council has been carrying out already. As part of this once a resilience coordinator has been found it would make sense for them to be one of the three identified contacts. The other two should be people who live in or work in the area.
- 4. Currently the clerk along with Cllr's Taylor, Hamilton, Keitch and Osborne have been working on various aspects of resilience from a Town Council, SSDC and SCC perspective. Members may wish for these members, along with the town clerk to form a Resilience Working Group that will look at identifying three people who will be willing for their names to be put forward as contacts.
- 5. Equally members may choose to wait until such time as the Community Resilience group is established and then put forward the names of people who might be willing to take on the role.
