RECOMMENDED

- (i) That the Committee considers if the existing play equipment at West Crescent should be refurbished
- (ii) That the Committee considers whether or not it wishes to refurbish the existing slide and swings
- (iii) That the Committee considers whether or not it wishes to add any money to the Tesco Bags Of Help grant to provide a greater range of play equipment at West Crescent

Consultation Update

- In accordance with the Committee's wishes, a consultation is underway regarding play equipment in West Crescent. A copy of the letter and questionnaire are attached as Appendix 1. The consultation letter has been delivered to approx 110 dwellings in the area adjacent to West Crescent and put on the Town Council website. At the time of preparing this report the response rate is 13% and the consultation has 1 more week to run.
- 2. The responses received so far have not been thoroughly read and the responses collated but early indications are that the play area is appreciated, and some new equipment would be welcome.

Play Equipment Maintenance and Provision

- The existing play equipment is 1 slide and 1 swing frame containing 2 flat seats and 2 cradle seats. The slide was purchased in 1990 and the swings in 1994.
- 4. The Open Spaces Team report that the existing play equipment is generally sound but dilapidated; the appearance could be improved by cleaning and repainting.
- 5. The safety matting is deteriorating and is monitored as part of the weekly safety checks.
- 6. The table below shows the purchase and cost information for the existing equipment

There is no budget provision in 2018/19 for an allocation to these earmarked reserves.

At current prices the cost of replacing the swings would be in excess of $\pounds 2,000$ the safety matting and installation costs would be additional. Current installation rates for play equipment range from $\pounds 500 - \pounds 1,300$ per day - depending upon the equipment type and the total amount of work required on the site.

7. The Tesco Bags Of Help grant is a £2,000 (already received) which must be spent on new play equipment for the West Crescent Play Area
