Dear Joy,
The License to the cricket club for the use of the pavilion was granted in March 1977; a subsequent enquiry as to the status of the licence was made by the then Town Clerk Steve Fisher in 2010. This seemed to conclude that the situation of the license agreement was dubious.

The Ilminster Cricket Club wish to move forward in improving the changing facilities in the existing pavilion which is the property of the Ilminster Educational Foundation. To enable the club to progress this project further (funding authorities require a minimum of 25 year security of tenure) the Ilminster Cricket Club would formally request that the Ilminster Town Council request that the Ilminster Educational Foundation give the ITC permission to change the current license to a Sub-Lease of their existing Lease agreement.
