SUSTRAND/CYCLE PATH

A visit to SUSTRANS in Bristol to discuss a 'cycle hub' at the junction of routes 30 & 33 has now been arranged for 9 October 2019. David, Liz and Colin attending.

FOOTBRIDGE OVER A303

Ref Martha's e-mail on this subject dated 22 September 2019, we remain confused.

STATION ROAD, PEDESTRIAN CONTROLLED CROSSING

The Sub-Group is convinced about the necessity of providing a crossing (with lights) in order to connect north and south (somewhere in the vicinity of the river).

CYCLE HUB, SHUDRICK LANE (BOTTOM OF WALNUT CLOSE)

The Sub-Group remains non-plussed about the lack of discussion/interest shown about this by the Ilminster Neighbourhood Plan group as a whole, compared with other potential sites discussed.

WEST CRESCENT TO GREENHILL FARM SITE

We are concerned that our idea of developing this site is not being taken more seriously by the Development Group as a whole.

A development on this site could accommodate a considerable number of houses (150-250) and should include bicycle/walk-ways linked to existing foot and cycle paths.

DEVELOPMENT ON THIS SITE WILL OBLVIATE ANY NEED TO DEVELOP SHUDRICK VALLEY.

The Sub-Group is puzzled as to why this site does not generate more interest.
