Good evening to you all, since the last Police report we have remained busy, dealing with the usual and the unusual things that occur in our Town and surrounding villages.

Over the last 4 weeks or so, I can report the following have occurred within Ilminster town itself.

6 x theft from shops etc

3 x harassment,

7 x Criminal damage, not linked to anything else.

2 x ASB incidents.

6 x assaults, 3 were same incident (3 victims)

0 x drugs

3 x sexual offences (1 is a historic offence)

1 x vehicle crime (theft of vehicle)

3 x public order offence.

3 x burg non dwelling

1 x burg dwelling

Of the assaults, 3 were from one incident, a group being attacked by a known male.

2 of the above criminal damage is recording of "newly found" but probably quite old graffiti.
