Pitch Maintenance Plan

2017-2018 Season and Beyond

Summary

Ilminster Town Football Club (ITFC) currently have six adult teams playing on Saturdays and Sundays which include 4 men's teams and 2 ladies teams. Our teams play in the Somerset Senior League, The Devon and Exeter League, The Perry Street League, The SWWFL Eastern League and Somerset County League. These varying leagues all have different criteria for pitches which this plan aims to satisfy.

ITFC moved premises at the start of the 2016/17 season to the Archie Gooch Pavilion, alongside which a new pitch (Pavilion pitch) was established. The club continues to use the existing (Grandstand pitch) both shown on the plan below.



This pitch maintenance document has been written to detail the immediate work needed to bring our pitches up to the required standard and their continued maintenance going forward.

Maintenance Plan

Aeration

The pitches will be aerated/de-compacted every two months. This will be performed by ITFCs spiker (on order and funded by ITFC). Any stone or flicked up during this operation should be removed.

Also twice a year at the end of the playing season (May) and in September the pitch will be Vertidrained (Deep aeration and earth quaking).

Top Dressing

To ensure the surface of the pitches remains free draining and smooth they should be top dressed with 30 tons/ha of sand twice per annum. This will occur following the playing season (May). *Overseeding*

Following the playing seasons the pitches will be overseeded using a three or four variety ryegrass mix. The seeding rate should be between 25 and 35g/m2 depending on the level of cover at the time of top dressing. Additional overseeding may occur in September and up to Christmas if the surface looks thin.

Fertiliser

The pitches will require around four applications of granular Fertiliser per year.

Cutting

Cutting will be maintained at the beginning of the season at 35 mm. At the end of the playing season the grass will be lowered to 25 mm to allow for renovation. Cutting will vary in pattern to prevent knap forming.

Pitch Surround and Protection

To meet the FA requirement for our Pavilion pitch it must be surrounded by railings. To date we have purchased an installed railings alongside the Pavilion and have enough ground spikes and galvanised steel to complete this edge and the far edge.

The same is required on the Grandstand pitch, but because of extensive pitch maintenance carried out and funded by ITFC we would reduce the sand needed to 15 tonne (one lorry load- saving £720 off the cost), and minus the railings and spike cost.
