Work Undertaken

- Pruned roses at the Burma Star Garden
- Continued to cut the grass in all areas
- Taken down A chain in Wharf Lane children's Park due to health and safety risk. (The bolts were worn at each end and unsafe so removed.)
- Reinstated the log bench on Herne hill as it had rolled down to bottom of the hill, has now been staked in place.

- Cut back the entrance to the Archie Gooch Pavilion to give better visibility when pulling out on to the road.
- Chippings has been put down on the path in Britten's fields to try and stop path from becoming muddy.
- 3 board walks have been made for use if Path becomes too muddy in Britten's Field.
- Rolled the ground where the fair was to push down wheel marks left.
- Strimmed and opened up Ridge path.
