Citizen's Award Guidance Notes



The Citizens Award is intended to recognise individuals who have made a positive contribution to Ilminster

Previous awards have been made to people for a wide variety of reasons some examples are:

- instigating an annual town event,
- litter picking,
- fundraising,
- volunteering
- working with young people
- working with a local club or organsiation over a long period of time

Criteria for making a Nomination

- 1. Nominees and those making the nominations for the Citizen's Award must be on the Electoral Roll for Ilminster
- 2. Nominations must be signed by three individuals who are on the electoral role for Ilminster
- 3. Nominations are not accepted from organisations or societies
- 4. The award may be issued posthumously provided that the nomination closing date is no more than 1 year since the nominee deceased
- 5. Serving Councillors from County, District or the Town Council are not eligible for nomination
- 6. Nominees should not be told of their nomination.
- 7. Nomination forms should either be completed in blank ink or typed
