Speaker 1

Last week the local MP was reported to have said that planners need to think holistically about a new town on the A303 not just about bolt-ons to existing residential areas, does this assist the Town council in any way when discussing planning applications.

The Chairman responded that this did not directly provide a planning reason which could be applied to a planning application so would not have a direct impact on recommendations and decisions.

Speaker 2

This speaker addressed the Committee regarding Planning application No. 18/03454/OUT – Land Adj Winterhay Lane Farm, The Beacon, Ilminster. The speaker said that they felt there was a good diversity of housing type in Ilminster and it should be recognised that having such a wide range is attracts people to the town. Latterly there has been a lot of housing estate development which meets the needs of many people but there has been a lack of one-off dwellings built and small-scale developments with good landscaping; such individual development should be encouraged. Whilst the speaker supports the application their 2 comments are that it would be improved if 4 houses were provided rather than 2 and the landscaping provision should include good screening provided by trees and hedges.

The Chair took the meeting into formal session.

The Chair asked the Committee's approval, which was given to take the Parking and Public Transport Agenda items immediately after the first planning application had been considered, this was to enable people attending specifically for those items to leave the meeting and fulfil other commitments.

Outline application for the erection of two dwellings with garaging. Issues discussed during consideration of this application included:

- The houses will be below the eye line of people on the road and pavement in New Road, so there will be minimal visual impact
- The proposed dwellings are fairly large house
- The site may have capacity for more houses
- Potential of noise from the A303
- The development would use an existing access

P228 Parking

(i) Countywide Parking Review

The County Councillor explained that currently requests for parking restrictions and parking schemes are dealt within a piecemeal manner so there will now be a county wide review to encourage a more holistic approach within communities. In the future it is likely that people / organisations making requests will have to fund the cost of any changes. It will be at least 6-9 months before Ilminster is reviewed and one-off changes will not be considered.

Issues raised during discussion on this agenda item included:

- Possible changes / rationalisation of parking charges e.g. for residents parking across the county
- that Town Council representatives to organisations such as the Chamber of Commerce should advise them about the parking review

RESOLVED to note the information

(ii) Double Yellow Lines in Berryman's Lane

At the 10 April 2018 Committee meeting a request was considered from a member of the public to have parking restrictions in Berryman's Lane; the Committee resolved to review the situation in 1 year i.e. April 2019. This item had been put on the Agenda due to the one-off parking restriction requests not being dealt with once the county wide parking review had commenced.

Issues discussed during consideration of this agenda item included:

· the narrowness of the road does restrict parking

RESOLVED not to request parking restrictions in Berrymans Lane

P229. Public Transport Provision

As a result of public transport provision being raised by members of the public at Council and Committee meetings and the matter being discussed by Councillors, the town Clerk had contacted the County Council about the current availability of public transport and community transport schemes.

The County Councillor said that the new shuttle service introduced in September 2018 seems to have been successful. The County Councillor uses the shuttle service but has noticed that she is often the only fare paying passenger and so this raises the question does the level of usage justify the service provision?

Issues discussed during consideration of this agenda item included:

- there are buses to Taunton but not to Chard & Yeovil
- the timetable allows 7 minutes to make a connection what happens if a bus is delayed due to traffic conditions? the County Cllr said that in her experience the shuttle service does try to help and wait if possible but that the main bus is unlikely to wait if the shuttle service is delayed
- transport is a theme of the emerging neighbourhood plan
